Under Texas Government Code §2110.008(b), an advisory committee is automatically abolished on the fourth anniversary of the date of its creation. Because the law creating the TWC Advisory Committee became effective September 1, 2003, the automatic abolishment date of the TWC Advisory Committee is September 1, 2007; therefore, these rules are no longer required.
